CHINA INTERNATIONAL CHORUS FESTIVAL AND IFCM WORLD CHORAL EDUCATION CONFERENCE

Beijing, China, 19 July to 25 July 2018

The four top choirs invited to the China International Chorus Festival in July have now been selected:

- From Gabon, **le Chant sur la Lowé**, conducted by Yveline Damas.
- From Hungary, the **Pannon Voices Mixed Choir**, conducted by Adrienne Vinczeffy.
- From New-Zealand, **Viva Voce**, conducted by John Rosser, will be the ambassador of the coming WSCM2020 in Auckland.
- From the USA, the **Houston Children's Choir**, conducted by Steve Rodde.

Also part of the CICF artistic program, the **World Youth Choir**, composed of young singers from all over the world, will rehearse during two weeks in Hohhot, Inner Mongolia, before a concert tour that will end at the CICF.

This week, discover **le Chant sur la Lowé**!

The Vocal Group *Le Chant sur la Lowé* was founded by Ms. Yveline Damas in December 1990. Composed of thirty members, the choir aims to develop, popularize and enhance Gabonese musical heritage by singing in every Gabonese language. In Gabon, like in many other African countries, singing is part of the daily life. Songs and dances help with regular activities but also play an important part in the healing process, from a disease's diagnosis to the harvest of the medicinal plants that will cure the patient. Stories and characters from traditional tales are taught through singing in order to encourage harmony. Thanks to a careful selection of costumes, choreographies and musical repertoires, *Le Chant sur la Lowé* works at promoting the cultural heritage of Africa in general and of Gabon in particular, but also performs classical, religious, popular and contemporary songs from Africa and other continents.



And now the three Master Classes:

1. Choral performance - Erik Van Nevel

Main Points:

- Difference between performance practice and interpretation;
- Method and technique of arrangement and choreography;
- Using certain works to practice.

2. Brain Gym training of children's choir - Fumiyo Tozaki

Main Points:

- How to improve the vocal skills for children (teenagers) with Brain Gym;
- How to concentrate on the rehearsals for children with Brain Gym.

3. Rhythm Training - Cristian Grases

Main Points:

- Basic Conducting Techniques for Rhythmic Music;
- Eurhythmics in the Rehearsal and the Performance.

Tarik O'Regan was awarded the 2018 ACDA Raymond W. Brock Memorial Commission. His work *All Things Common* was premiered at each of ACDA's six regional conferences this spring. About the piece, he notes: *Despite the text's Biblical origins, I wanted to find a theme*



which can speak to everyone ... I feel we live in a time of exceptional division, and that we are using our great and wonderful diversity (in every sense) against ourselves towards our demise, rather than embracing it for our greater good All Things Common is published by Novello.

Matthew Hazzard, a graduate student at California State University - Long Beach, won the 2017 ACDA Brock Student Composition Competition for his work *Peace Flows into Me*. The piece was premiered at the ACDA Western Region Conference in March 2018.

**NEWS FROM IFCM MEMBERS****OBITUARY JOSÉ ANTONIO ABREU (1939-2018)**

We are saddened by the loss of **Jose Antonio Abreu** who passed away last Sunday. Jose Antonio Abreu was a musician, politician and economist who created a network of more than 1,500 orchestras and choirs for young people in Venezuela, known as "El Maestro" in his home country. Abreu started the project in 1975, and his internationally-acclaimed "El Sistema" ("The System") has grown to include more than 900,000 children, taught by 10,000 teachers throughout Venezuela.

His innovative teaching model, which boasts replicas in 50 countries, has earned him a number of prestigious awards, including from UNESCO and the Royal Swedish Academy of Music.

In addition to his landmark music program, Abreu also played a role in Venezuelan politics: he was a legislator and also served as culture minister during president Carlos Andres Perez's second term.
