A session organized by (Choral) Conductors Without Borders (CWB)

under the leadership of A Coeur Joie International

Kinshasa (DR Congo) — 25-30 August 2014

A wonderful choral conductors' training session has taken place in Kinshasa, Republic of Congo, in August 2014, as a follow-up of all the actions undertaken by ACJ International since 2010.

About forty choral conductors participated; there were two levels (of which one under the direction of Jeff Esungi, a licensed local instructor).

The number of participants having taken part in earlier sessions is a remarkable proof of their progression ... as is the fact that everybody without exception was present every single day of this training week.

The local organizing team was excellent; the different logistic and administrative tasks were well taken care of.

Eight participants were selected to conduct the final concert with a choir of 70. Around ten pieces from Renaissance (by a vocal group of 12 carefully chosen singers) to contemporary compositions were presented ... as well as, of course, African polyphony.

Three new instructors were promoted: Jonathan Musengo, Charly and Ulysse Mbenzu. They complete the group of those already certified: Jeff Esungi and Joël Moleka (trainee instructor since 2013).

This means that an efficient local training team is now in place able to continue regular training between the bi-annual sessions.

Next session in DR Congo: 9 to 14 March 2015

Next CWB session in Africa: 27 October to 1 November 2014 in Libreville, Gabon, with Thierry Thiébaut and Anne-Marie Cabut (choir conducting and children singing week).
