

THE EUROPEAN CHORAL ASSOCIATION - EUROPA CANTAT (ECA-EC)

The <u>conference "Cross the line"</u> and the General Assembly of the European Choral Association - Europa Cantat took place in Utrecht (NL) from November 11 to 13 and was co-organised by ZIMIHC, one Dutch member organisation of ECA-EC.

The weekend started with the Membership Day, an occasion to collect members' and participants' feedbacks and outputs that will help structure the next conference and General Assembly that will take place in October 2017 in Tallinn, Estonia.

It continued with the opening of the conference with the keynote speech "Cross the line and leave a trail" by Nicolas Mansfield. On Saturday the General Assembly started with a Turkish touch on the notes of "Utrecht Kasap Havasi", and evolved around different issues, like the new project "Sing me In" and the upcoming events, including Europa Cantat Junior (See above) and the EUROPA CANTAT XX Festival in Tallinn (EE) in 2018 (http://ectallinn2018.ee/). The GA was followed by workshops and discussions.

The weekend ended with a musical wrap-up session with Merel Mertens and the inspiring concert "72 Angels" of the Netherlands Chamber Choir (NKK), conducted by Peter Dijkstra, together with the Raschèr Saxophone Quartet.

ACCADEMIA PIERGIORGIO RIGHELE, A BETTER PRACTICE IN CHORAL CONDUCTING EDUCATION

Four years ago in Verona, Italy, the regional choral association ASAC with the support of FENIARCO started a new Academy for Choral Conductors. Since then, 60 conductors have been trained through an intensive program of master classes, regular courses and seminars. The Academy offers three different levels of training: beginners level (15 conductors), intermediate level (15 conductors) and master level (8 conductors). Every course includes one or two training weekends per month during 8 months.

LEBANESE INTERNATIONAL CHOIR FESTIVAL (LICF)



The Lebanese International Choir Festival was organized for the first time in 2015 by Fayha Choir and Polyfollia in collaboration with Azm Cultural Center, Beit el Fann. It aims to promote choir singing and introduce different cultures through the participation of Lebanese and foreign choirs. More than 12 Lebanese and international choirs participated performing in different Lebanese cities and regions including Beirut, Byblos, Dannieh, Anjar and Tripoli, April 20-26, 2015.

The second edition will take place from May 15 to 21, 2017. It will bring together around 15 Lebanese choirs, and 6 regional and international choirs to perform a series of concerts in various cities and venues across Lebanon. The 6th Mediterranean Choral Forum will be organized by the Mediterranean Office for Choral Singing during the last three days of LICF and will be attended by all the participants in the concerts, workshops, conferences, and gala concerts in Tripoli. LICF II will further develop and improve the achievements of LICF I. It will be the choral event of 2017 in Lebanon and will demonstrate nationally and internationally the vitality, the richness and variety of the Lebanese choral scene and the Arab choral music. It will be an international meeting point for the main Mediterranean actors of the choral sector.
