WORLD SYMPOSIUM ON CHORAL MUSIC IN ISTANBUL (25-30 April 2023)

Here is the news that the IFCM community has been waiting for - the invited choirs for the WSCM 2023 Istanbul:

Estonian Philharmonic Chamber Choir (Estonia), Batavia Madrigal Singers (Indonesia), Fayha National Choir (Lebanon), Georgia State University Singers (USA), Leioa Kantika Korala (Spain), Le Chant Sur La Lowé (Gabon), Orfeón San Juan Bautista (Puerto Rico), Sofia Vokalensemble (Sweden), Taipei Philharmonic Chamber Choir (Taiwan), Turkish State Choir (Türkiye) and Vancouver Youth Choir (Canada).

Selected for their artistry as well as their concert programing's connection with the symposium's theme "Changing Horizons," each choir is an outstanding representation of its region and style. The IFCMeNEWS will feature all the WSCM 2023 choirs over the next few months. First to be highlighted are the professional choir, Estonian Philharmonic Chamber Choir, and the choir with the youngest singers, Leioa Kantika Korala.

Estonian Philharmonic Chamber Choir (EPCC), Estonia

The Estonian Philharmonic Chamber Choir (EPCC) is one of the best-known Estonian music ensembles in the world. The choir was founded in 1981 by Tonu Kaljuste who was its artistic director and chief conductor for twenty years. Followed by collaborative leadership with Paul Hillier, Daniel Reuss, and Kaspars Putninš, Tonu Kaljuste has returned as artistic director and chief conduction as of this season. A lifelong guest at many respected music festivals around the world, the EPCC has a wide recording repertoire and is a two-time GRAMMY Award winner with an impressive total of 16 GRAMMY Award nominations. It is not surprising that BBC Music Magazine (2020) named the EPCC as one of the best 10 choirs in the world.

Leioa Kantika Korala, with its 50 young singers ages 11 to 20, was founded in 2000 at the Leioa Municipal Conservatory by conductor Basilio Astúlez. The conductor and choristers pride themselves in exploring the widest possible variety of styles and repertoires. They have performed in numerous international festivals and have toured the world over, winning many prestigious awards at competitions in Arezzo, Gorizia, Neerpelt, and Rimini.

I think it's very important to give the opportunity to young people who are studying or don't have much experience to be able to learn how to actually work on the field and also to help them know and show what they're capable of. I feel that a generational change is happening within the IFCM, so I believe it's important to meet and train different young people to be part of its future.

I think it's an excellent opportunity for young people to learn how to manage and work in a festival as a team. And, on the other hand, this program can be a great help for a festival. Just amazing. Amazing idea, opportunity, experience, people.

WORLD SYMPOSIUM ON CHORAL MUSIC 2026

Call for expressions of interest for countries, regions, and/or cities to host the WSCM 2026 IFCM welcomes expressions of interest to host the World Symposium on Choral Music to be held in 2026. National organizations, institutions, or consortia interested in hosting the WSCM 2026 should submit a document (.doc, .docx or .pdf) by **28 February 2023**, including the following details:

- Name of organization/institution
- Mailing address of organization/institution
- Website of organization/institution
- Full name of primary contact person
- Email address of primary contact person
- Brief description regarding previous experience the organization/institution has in hosting choral events
- Brief description regarding the available infrastructure (buildings, rooms, spaces).

Because planning such events years in advance and securing them with the necessary funds has become more challenging in the recent years, your submission does not need to provide detailed numbers and facts. At the same time, it should include realistic funding expectations. Please send your submission to **office@ifcm.net before 28 February 2023**.

Your submission will be reviewed by the IFCM Board of Directors. Finalists will be able to meet the Board during the WSCM 2023 in Istanbul or after the event at the most convenient location for a deeper evaluation of the WSCM 2026 proposal.

WHY YOU SHOULD USE MUSICANET.ORG RATHER THAN GOOGLE!

Choral conductors sometimes ask this question. Decisive arguments abound!

Musica is infinitely better suited in searching for information related to choral repertoire as its database references the choral music 'score' and does not drown in all the other keywords which are included in comprehensive databases such as Google. This is because Musica is a 'structured' database. In this specialized database, a specific field exists for each category of information describing a score (composer, title, type of choir, number of voices, tonality, genre, style, form, instrumentation, liturgical use, etc.). The Musica database also provides access

to translations of the text, pronunciations, and videos of performances. All information in the database is collected and curated by specialists in choral singing.

There are many other reasons for using Musica! You will find them in this **article** comparing the Musica International database with Google or any other general search engine.

Dr. Jacob Youngmok Chang was elected 5th President of Korea International Choral Association (KICA) on 10 October 2022. KICA was established in 2009 for choral conductors, composers, choral music publishers, music critics, and singers who are interested in international choral activities.
