NEWS FROM IFCM FOUNDING MEMBERS

WSCM2020 IS CANCELLED

It is with enormous sadness that Symposium 2020 Ltd, in conjunction with the New Zealand Choral Federation and the International Federation for Choral Music, announces that the 12th World Symposium on Choral Music (WSCM2020), due to take place in Auckland, New Zealand from 11 to 18 July, is cancelled.

This decision is a direct result of the global outbreak of the coronavirus COVID-19 and has not been made lightly. The pandemic is still growing exponentially throughout much of the world, international flights are already severely affected, and the New Zealand Government has imposed stringent self-isolation rules on all incoming travellers, while also indicating that massed gatherings may soon be restricted. There is no guarantee that the situation will have changed markedly by July.

Concern over the virus has meant that delegates have become reluctant to travel. Choirs and presenters are increasingly asking for assurance, which is of course impossible to give. In the current climate, WSCM2020 is not sustainable. We have no option but to cancel now and provide a sense of certainty for all those affected, despite the huge disappointment that will accompany it.

We were thrilled by the quality of the choirs and presenters we were able to select from a record number of applications, and excited by the programme that had been created around them. It is a devastating blow not to be able to present this now to an eager audience. All we can do is send our deep regrets and sincere thanks to every singer, conductor, partner, funder, administrator, registrant, staff member and volunteer who has supported us on this WSCM2020 journey.

All registration and concert tickets will be refunded, but we do ask for your patience while our team works through this process, as we will be inundated with enquires.


IFCM IS LOOKING FOR TRANSLATORS



SURVEY FROM THE INTERNATIONAL MUSIC COUNCIL (IMC)

The Coronavirus is spreading world-wide and the crisis is severely affecting public, cultural and social life. The music ecosystem has already been hit heavily and will continue to be massively affected by the measures taken to prevent any further spread of the virus.

Our colleagues at the European Music Council have issued a statement with regard to the music sector in Europe. EMC also developed a short survey to get a better picture on how the sector is affected.

THE EUROPEAN FORUM OF THE EUROPEAN MUSIC COUNCIL CANCELLED

It is with deep regret that the **EMC** Board has decided to cancel the European Forum on Music 2020 which was scheduled to take place from 4 - 7 June 2020 in Bonn, Germany. The uncertainty created by the spread of the Coronavirus worldwide and the measures taken to contain it, do not make it possible for the EMC to continue with the event as planned.

This also effects the Annual Meeting scheduled for 7 June 2020 in the framework of the EFM. The Annual Meeting 2020 will be postponed to a later date this year.

To our choral colleagues around the world, please know that **Choral Canada** stands with you in these unprecedented times. We have all been heartbroken to see our artistic seasons and all the beautiful, community-driven music projects we have been preparing over recent months seemingly vanish, or at least be put on indefinite hold, as the planet deals with the global health crisis at hand. We are devastated for our students and their institutions, seeing educational programs cancelled or moved online, an impractical solution for musicians. We are sorry to see



our industry members have their businesses feel the impact of these troubling economic times. Like us, choral organizations around the globe are cancelling many programs that were created to serve you, our choral community. We long for a time when we will all be able to come together to sing our stories once again. However, that time is not yet here.

Given the circumstances in which we all find ourselves due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we regret to inform you that [PODIUM 2020](#) and the [National Youth Choir](#) program will not take place in Montreal, Quebec, 14-17 May 2020, as planned.

THE 66TH CORK INTERNATIONAL CHORAL FESTIVAL IS CANCELLED

It is with considerable regret that the Board of the Cork International Choral Festival (planned on 29 Apr-3 May) announces the cancellation of this year's Festival. The Festival's Board took this difficult decision based on the present situation at national and European level in relation to the Covid-19 virus.

The Board is very conscious that this decision will impact more than 5,000 choir members, who would have been participating in the Festival, 800 of whom were travelling from abroad. The Board wishes to thank all those groups who have financially supported the planning of this year's event and expresses the greatest support to all those impacted by this unprecedented situation in their country.

To accommodate the current questions and suggestions of the participants, the organization will, for the first time in the 68-year history of the European Music Festival for Young People, postpone its yearly event until the weekend of **11-14 September 2020**.

All registered groups will be able to participate in September without any additional administrative activities or costs. Furthermore, the registration period will reopen for other choirs wishing to participate in the September 2020 edition.

The Board of Directors, on the proposal of the Organizing Committee and in accordance with the guidelines given, has decided to postpone it to 2021.

The **new application deadline is September 30, 2020**. The choirs invited this year will be given priority, should they want to participate in 2021.

THE 12TH EUROPEAN YOUTH CHOIR FESTIVAL BASEL IS CANCELLED

With great regret, the Board of Directors of the [European Youth Choir Festival Basel](#) announces that the 12th European Youth Choir Festival Basel from 20-24 May 2020 has been cancelled. It is no longer possible for the festival to take place due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The decision was made after careful consideration and consultation with relevant authorities.

Unfortunately, it will not be possible to hold the festival at a later date either. The 13th European Youth Choir Festival Basel will therefore take place from **24-29 May 2022**. The **deadline for applications will be 31 January 2021**.
