WORLD SYMPOSIUM ON CHORAL MUSIC IN ISTANBUL (25-30 April 2023)

While the upper hemisphere is getting ready for the winter, the WSCM 2023 team is working away to provide you with an event-packed, entertaining, educational, inspiring, and uplifting experience at the long-awaited WSCM 2023 in Istanbul. **Registration is now open**. You have until **1 January 2023** to register with the **Early Bird** fee. **Masterclass** applicants need to act a little quicker as the deadline for application is **15 December 2022** (please see the <u>website</u> for details on masterclass application conditions).

It is highly recommended that you book your accommodations early, as spring is a popular time for Istanbul and you want to make sure you are in the perfect location to make the most of the symposium. The area where most events will be held is called Taksim, also referred to as Beyoglu. Nearby areas are Sishane (20-minute walk) and Sisli (30-minute walk or 10-minute using the underground metro - which has a major stop right under the WSCM 2023 main campus, the Atatürk Cultural Centre).

Before you know it, it will be spring in Istanbul, and it will be perfect weather, no matter which hemisphere you come from. The snow will have melted, and you will enjoy a city in bloom, which you will have a chance to explore between sessions, presentations, and concerts. We look forward to welcoming you to Istanbul!

The America Cantat 10 festival will take place in the City of La Plata, Argentina (capital of the Province of Buenos Aires), 11-15 October 2023. We will celebrate the 30th anniversary of the first version of America Cantat which was held in Mar del Plata, Argentina, in 1992.

The America Cantat was repeated in Mar del Plata in 1996 and then traveled to Venezuela in 2000, Mexico in 2004, Cuba in 2007, Brazil in 2010, Colombia in 2013, Bahamas in 2016, and Panama in 2019. JOB OFFER: CHORUS DIRECTOR AT THE EDINBURGH FESTIVAL CHORUS

The Edinburgh International Festival seeks expressions of interest from world class choral directors to succeed Aidan Oliver as **Chorus Director** of the **Edinburgh Festival Chorus** from Autumn 2023.

The Edinburgh Festival Chorus has been at the heart of the International Festival since its foundation in 1965 and performs a number of programmes each year with some of the finest international orchestras including the London Symphony Orchestra, Los Angeles Philharmonic, Czech Philharmonic and Orchestre de Paris and conductors including Sir Andrew Davis, Gustavo Dudamel, Sir Simon Rattle and Marin Alsop.

The current rehearsal schedule has regular weekly rehearsals held in Edinburgh on a Tuesday evening (October – June); a shorter augmenter group in Glasgow currently on a Monday evening (January – March); a number of weekends throughout the season (currently 4) and an additional intensive weekend of rehearsals in the period immediately before the festival.
