THE WORLD SYMPOSIUM ON CHORAL MUSIC 2023 GOES TO ISTANBUL, TURKEY

We are happy to announce that the World Symposium on Choral Music (WSCM), one of the biggest events of the International Federation for Choral Music, will be held in Turkey from 25th to 30th of April 2023 with the support of the Turkish Ministry of Culture and Tourism. The event will be organized by the Turkish representative of IFCM, the Choral Culture Association.

The event promotes artistic excellence, cooperation and exchange, by bringing together the finest choirs and choral leaders for performances, seminars, workshops, exhibitions, and choral reading sessions. The theme of 2023, "**Changing Horizons**", aims to introduce as many singing traditions as possible from across the globe. WSCM 2023 invites submissions for presentations that are rooted in the exploration of diverse singing styles and traditions within countries and/or regions, showcasing collective singing practices that represent varied social, ethnic, geographical, and/or cultural backgrounds, encouraging presentation proposals that align with the symposium theme. Moreover, choirs and vocal ensembles are encouraged to bring creative programs grounded in diversity through the inclusion of repertoire and performance practices that showcase different social, ethnic, geographical, and/or cultural backgrounds within each ensemble's region.

EuroChoir on tour through Switzerland! 7-18 July 2022

The international choir project EuroChoir of the European Choral Association takes place in a different country every year. This summer it is Switzerland's turn to enjoy EuroChoir concerts! After an intensive week of rehearsals in Lenk in the mountains of the canton of Bern, the choir consisting of selected young singers from all over Europe will start its Swiss tour on Friday, 15 July 2022, at Peterskirche in Basel. The EuroChoir will be welcomed by the local women's vocal ensemble Les Voix. On Saturday, 16 July 2022, the EuroChoir will perform its programme as



part of the Flimsfestival at Eventhalle Flims. It will be hosted by the young local choir consonus vokalensemble. The tour will conclude with a concert on Sunday, 17 July 2022, at Klosterkirche Rheinau as part of the Rheinauer Konzerte together with Vokalensemble **Zürich West**. In addition to works by F. Martin, F. Poulenc, and F. Mendelssohn, the concerts will also feature the world premiere of the commissioned composition "How dare you!"; named after the famous speech by Greta Thunberg and written by Swiss composer Valentin Villard.

FAYHA CHOIR BECOMES THE FIRST NATIONAL CHOIR OF LEBANON

The Ministry of Culture of Lebanon recently named **Fayha Choir** the Lebanese National Choir. The Minister of Culture congratulated Fayha Choir and wrote: "Fayha Choir reflects diversity, rejects fanaticism, and broadcasts the national spirit in a sober and refined way". Congratulations to Fayha Choir and its conductor Barkev Taslakian!

LEBANON CHOIR FOR PEACE

A new project of Fayha Choir, in partnership with United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) which is supported by Germany through KfW Development Bank, gathered more than 120 youth from four districts in Lebanon: North, South, Bekaa and Mount Lebanon. This national choir aims to create a common platform for people from different backgrounds, religions, sects, generations, and villages.

Lebanon Choir for Peace is a model for inter- and intra-communal initiatives and reflects a good example of citizenship by giving its members more ability and motivation to play a role in solving local problems as local peace agents. It is a local conflict transformative project and will contribute to developing a better response to local tensions and conflicts, which ultimately



contributes to the promotion of social cohesion in Lebanon.

This initiative also comes within Fayha Choir's plan for promoting collective singing in Lebanon and Arab countries. Enjoy this [video](#) from the first joint rehearsal in which singers met for the first time, conducted by Maestro Barkev Taslakian.
