

On 29 October 2023, a Conductors Café, *Panorama Actual de la Música Coral* (current picture of choral music), was organized for IFCM members and non-members within the Latin-American region. GREAT RESPONSE FROM COMPOSERS TO THE NEXT IFCM CHORAL COMPOSITION COMPETITION

IFCM's 6^{th} International Choral Composition Competition 2023/2024 has generated an impressive response from composers all over the world. A total of 100 applications have been





received from more than 30 countries, with 76 entries in the *Mixed* category and 24 in the *World Choral Day* category. The global representation of composers reveals the extraordinary diversity within the international choral music industry. This competition provides an exceptional opportunity for these composers to showcase their unique talents.

The jury members have begun the process of reviewing the submissions and will convene in November to share their evaluations and determine the winners of the competition. The announcement of the winners of the 6th International Choral Competition 2023/2024 will be published by the end of November 2023. The competition has undoubtedly stirred excitement and anticipation within the global choral community.

As the IFCM International Choral Composition Competition continues to grow in popularity, it remains a testament to the artistic flair and creativity of choral music composers worldwide. The competition provides a platform which promotes emerging talent and fosters the growth of the choral music industry as a whole.



CALL FOR YOUNG SINGERS IN THE ASIA PACIFIC REGION FOR APYC 2024!

The next session of the Asia Pacific Youth Choir (APYC) will be held in Daegu, South Korea, 14-20 July 2024. The session will be under the leadership of:

- Music Director: **Jacob Youngmok Chang** (Republic of Korea), President of Korea International Choral Association, Former President of Daegu Art University
- Guest Conductor: **Mark Anthony Carpio** (Philippines), choral conductor, countertenor, choirmaster of the Philippine Madrigal Singers

Conditions of participation:

- Applicants must be between 18 to 28 years of age on 14 July 2024.
- A good working knowledge of English is required as all events will be conducted in English.
- Accommodation, meals, and all material needs are provided by the host organization.
- Participants are responsible for their own financial resources for the following:
 - Travel from home country to host country (Daegu, South Korea), and back to home country
 - Visas and other official requirements
 - Pocket money for personal expenses

EUROPEAN CHORAL ASSOCIATION COLLECTIVE SINGING AS INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE

Advocacy statement on the safeguarding of collective singing traditions

With the European Union declaring 2018 as the European Year of Cultural Heritage, broader public awareness for the safeguarding of our collective singing heritage increased across Europe, and new initiatives and projects were born. Yet, despite the 20-year existence of the UNESCO Convention for the Safeguarding of the Intangible Cultural Heritage, there is still, and all too often, a focus on tangible heritage, whereas intangible heritage is not always fully recognized.



Since vocal music, which includes choral music and collective singing in general, has the largest number of intangible heritage traditions listed by UNESCO within the field of music, the European Choral Association decided to publish an advocacy statement calling on decision-makers and cultural heritage professionals to fully recognize the importance and role of intangible cultural heritage and to encourage measures of support, protection, and promotion.

The statement also calls on persons active in the education sector to integrate collective singing traditions in their work with all age groups.
