IFCM WORKING COMMITTEES

IFCM Board restructures its committees in order to better serve the choral community.

During their third meeting on 25 May 2023, newly-elected Board members worked positively and actively to confirm the new structure of the working committees responsible for managing the various matters of IFCM.

Here is an overview of the overall organizational categories with sub-committees and/or a summary of tasks:

The Big SIX

- **1. Programs**: World Symposium on Choral Music 2026, World Choral EXPO, World Choral Day, Composition Competition, and the festivals in China.
- **2.Governance**: The tasks of this committee are to monitor Bylaws and internal policy documents as needed, develop a Code of Ethics, and oversee the election process. The committee will also ensure that IFCM commits to and prioritizes inclusion and diversity.
- **3.Education and Outreach**: Conductors Without Borders, YOUNG program, YOUNG IFCM, Central Asia Youth Choir, online activities.
- 4. Membership: Communication with members and Creating Futures in Choral Music program.
- 5. Fundraising and Marketing.
- **6.Communication**: Oversight includes website, social media, *International Choral Magazine*, and IFCMeNEWS.

Partnerships continue also between IFCM and the International Music Council, the European Music Council, Musica International, Africa Cantat, America Cantat, the World Youth Choir Foundation, and the Asia Pacific Choral Council for the Asia Pacific Youth Choir.

IFCM CHORAL COMPOSITION COMPETITION 2023/2024

IFCM has organized five international choral composition competitions since this project was created in 2010. The aim of these competitions is to promote the creation and distribution of new and accessible choral repertoire.

IFCM announces its **6th International Competition for Choral Composition** to promote new works in choral music and to encourage innovation in choral writing which fits the needs of a 21st-century choir. We are looking for compositions that combine originality, imagination, and creativity within the context of contemporary global themes.

Deadline: 30 September 2023. Submissions to be sent to secretarygeneral@ifcm.net. Applications fees are US\$12.00 (HDI3) / 18.00 (HDI2) / 25.00 (HDI1)). Fees vary according to the country of nationality of the composer.

MUSICA INTERNATIONAL

Anticipate great composers' anniversaries with the help of Musica International

Musica International (<u>www.musicanet.org</u>), a multimedia collaborative database of the world's choral repertoire, publishes a comprehensive list of all composers cited in Musica having a jubilee (100, 150, 200, 250 years, etc.) anniversary during the current year and the following three years. This represents hundreds of composers for each of these years.

2nd FICFE INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF FEMALE CHOIRS IN LATIN AMERICA 19-24 November 2023, Tlaquepaque, Jalisco, Mexico

FICFE's International Festival of Female Choirs in Latin America (festival Internacional de Coros Femeninos en Latinoamérica) evolves from the interest in music originally composed for female voices and the need to make their presence visible in the artistic and Latin American cultural field.

An independent cultural project, the festival's objective is to generate and consolidate a space for meeting and exchange between choral groups formed by women from Latin America and the world, sharing different repertoires, projects, and cultural experiences throughout concerts, conferences, and workshops presented by renowned figures from the international choral field. FICFE is held every two years in different Latin American countries. Its first edition was in 2019 in Puerto Madryn, Chubut province, Argentina. The second edition will take place in San Pedro Tlaquepaque, Jalisco, Mexico, 19-24 November 2023. The interpretation workshops will be held by Marjukka Riihimähki (Finland), Patricia Morales and Gabriela Franco (Mexico). FICFE also has a Composition Contest which alternates with the festival project.

JUNGES VOKALENSEMBLE HANNOVER GERMANY ON NEW ZEALAND & AUSTRALIA TOURTHIS JULY AND AUGUST

During its tour in New Zealand and Australia, the mixed choir **Junges Vokalensemble Hannover** (JVH) will perform compositions by German composers e.g. Bach, Brahms, Mendelssohn Bartholdy, Rheinberger, and by the contemporary Australian composer Luke Byrne. In Germany Byrne has worked two times with JVH, furthermore, in 2023, he has written the commissioned work RAINFOREST for the choir.

Originally invited, in 2020, to the World Symposium on Choral Music in Auckland, JVH had additionally planned visiting partner choirs in five cities in New Zealand and Australia. Now that the Covid-19 pandemic is over, the choir is very happy to realize this tour in 2023.

JVH regularly goes on guest performance tours and international choral competitions all over the world. JVH is deeply grateful to all partner choirs for their warm and persistent welcome and cooperation in joint concerts and to all sponsors for their generous funding. This tour will take the choir to the last continent not yet visited.
